Personal

The Department of Health have told us that people with learning disabilities can have funding to allow them to have more personalised care and services. We want to know how well this is working for BAME communities.

What does A stand for?



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Advocacy

Advocacy means to speak up for yourself or for someone else.

An advocate is a person who can support you to make your voice and your views heard.

'I am sometimes don't get along with people, I don't understand what they are talking about. I have a lot of pains but I just don't know how to say them'

We may find people from BAME communities are having the same experiences.

We may all learn from these experiences if we share our stories.
